PRACTICE TEACHING AND INTERNSHIP:

• To develop the teaching competencies, methodologies and confidence of the student teachers.

The internship period is a very crucial aspect of the B. Ed programme. This period sees provides the student teachers with the necessary experience of interacting and practice teaching in schools. Students undergo Internship for 18 to 20 weeks during the second, third and fourth semester of this two-year programme.

For the academic year 2018-19, the students of PCER went to 10 various schools and junior colleges for their Internship wherein they shadowed the school subject teachers, gave lessons in their chosen pedagogy and completed several activities as required by the Internship programme.

EXTENSION:

- To sensitize students towards the needs of the marginalized society
- To prepare students to be socially responsible citizens

There were extension related activities of the of the Department of Life Long Learning & Extension, Mumbai University in which the students participated. The students of F. Y. B. Ed conducted their activities at college and University levels under two categories PEC and SWS.

Under PEC the students conducted lessons in their internship schools as well as co curricular activities on topics like health and hygiene, importance of healthy diet, taking care of self, sex education, self-defense, caring our surrounding, responsibility towards resources- water, electricity.

Under SWS the students conducted surveys on various issues related to women. The various topics selected were domestic violence, attitude towards girl child, work-life balance etc. The students conducted street-plays on 'Domestic Violence' in various parts of Greater Mumbai.

The students also participated in the Mumbai University Extension Festival-UDAAN. Students performed a Street Play on the theme 'Dowry System' and also participated in Poster Making Competition.

COMMUNITY WORK:

• To inculcate in student teachers the attitude of giving back to society.

The students were allocated to various NGOs and centres such as Lend a Hand, NASEOH where they carried out various activities as per the requirement of the centre. They also conducted an Adult Literacy Drive teaching basic language skills to women from the economically weaker section. Some of the activities conducted were Wall painting, teaching aids preparation, learning resource preparation, craftwork, candle, paper bags making, chocolate making and remedial teaching.

Community service day was celebrated on 2nd February 2019 at Dr. K.M.Vasudevan Pillai Campus, Panvel. Students from NASEOH Chembur were invited and taken to Panvel. Post lunch they were taken to respective activity area. PCER students conducted various activities for the NASEOH students and spent time fruitfully.

Placements:

The Career Cell of PCER aims at making available quality placement opportunities for the student teachers of the college. The placement cell also provides for personal grooming, personal support and counseling in seeking jobs in good schools. Students are oriented about preparing an effective curriculum vitae and appearing for interviews. Personal guidance is given to the student- teachers to facilitate them to take up the most apt job opportunity.
