## Academic journey PCER 2020

### ASSEMBLY

The morning assembly is very much exciting and a well appreciated activity by all, it always brought a feeling of togetherness and oneness among staff and students. Assembly consists of

prayer, thoughts for the day, news headlines, personal opinions on values. The assembly theme for the year was on Environment protection and sustainability. The students recorded their activities and shared it in the WhatsApp platform, as the physical classrooms were suspended due to the covid-19 lockdown. Every month different themes were given and the activities were organized according to the theme. The July month activities were on the theme 'unity in diversity' and August was on 'Patriotism' emphasizing values of peace, tolerance, fraternity, Brotherhood respect, empathy and sacrifice. The assembly for the month September was based on the values related to the festival of Ganesh Chaturthi and special days such as world Ozone day, world Social Justice day and World Tourism day were observed as special assembly programs. The assembly program for October focused on the theme of 'pluralism and the values advocated by Mahatma Gandhi. The special days included World Nature Day, World Food Day and Rashtriya Ekta Diwas.

In the month of November assembly was centred around Diwali celebrations and in December activities were centred around the theme 'Joy of giving'. ## PRACTICE TEACHING

In the month of July, students were given a lot of opportunities through online platforms to enrich their content knowledge. This paved the way in the month of August wherein they started their Internship period from 10th August, 2020. The demonstration lectures by the pedagogy professors helped the student teachers to be oriented towards presenting recorded/ live lessons under the supervision of teacher educators via Google Meet. This process not only helped the student teachers to be thorough with the pedagogy of teaching but also removed screen inhibitions. The continuous guidance with improving their lesson plans and executing their lessons smoothly helped in the smooth sailing of their practice teaching through their internship period. They also started maintaining their Reflective Journal to introspect and excel in their daily activities.

The Practice Teaching Department organized a session via Google Meet on the topic 'Create Quiz through Google Forms' in the month of September, 2020

Student teachers were carried out their Internship for 4 weeks and 1 week of community work during their Semester-IV. Students developed learning resources and conduct action research as part of their activities. They also needed to take 5 lessons of their second pedagogy and 5 co-teaching lessons with peers. Among the 5 co-teaching lessons with peers, 2 were to be taken as Nai Talim Lessons. Student teachers were trained to write reflective journals that would help them to record the internship activities.

Student teachers carried out the various activities that are part of their Semester 4 practice teaching. The four weeks of internship commenced from the third week of January. They gave five lessons in their second pedagogy and five co-teaching lessons with peers. Students also prepared various digital learning resources in their pedagogy and conducted an action research as part of their

activities. Student teachers maintained a systematic record of their internship activities in their reflective journals.

#### EXTENSION:

The extension department at PCER always committed to its goal and always acts as a bridge to connect students to community through its various activities. University of Mumbai, Department of Lifelong Learning and Extension & MES's PCER, Chembur organized the Slogan and Poster making Competition. The theme was "Sustainable Living during COVID-19". The Women Development Cell and Extension Cell of PCER Chembur celebrates Human Rights Day on 10th December, 2020 through a video showcasing the violations of various rights.

#### COMMUNITY WORK:

Community work is an integral part of B.Ed curriculum. The college collaborates with different organizations and places students in varied environments like working with the underprivileged sections of the society, mentally challenged children, environment centers for tree plantation, old age homes etc. Street plays on themes to educate the community like gender issues, cleanliness and sanitation are encouraged.

On the occasion of the 'International Day for the Eradication of Poverty' MES's PCER, Chembur in collaboration with Soroptimist Welfare Association (SIBC) organized the Project - Fistful of Grains to donate food items to the marginalized sections of the society. The items were placed in the Amazon Registry (link of Amazon Registry and video for transaction is provided). There were hundreds of well-wishers including students, alumni, teaching and non-teaching staff MES and many others who generously donated for the social cause. The delivery point was Chembur Campus. The people were allowed to make their purchases till 7th November, the items received were donated to orphanages. The various items collected included various types of Dal, Poha, Rawa, Rice, Wheat flour, Sugar, Cooking Oil, Salt etc. The collected items were segregated into 4 packages and despatched to various orphanages. The total quantity of items purchased; Rice -51 Kg worth INR- 31,462/-, Oil -51 Litres worth INR-6150/-, Tea powder- 23Kgs worth INR-5980/-, Wheat Flour-300kg, worth INR12,744/-, Rawa-22kg worth INR-726/-, Poha-51 kg worth INR-2091/-, Green Gram-40 kg worth INR-4800/-Chickpeas-31kg, worth INR-3410/-, Sugar-20 kg, worth INR-836/-, Split pigeon peas, 54 kg worth INR-6318/-, Orange Lentils-33 kgs worth INR-3300/-, Salt-53 kgs worth INR-954/-. There were 4 gift cards worth INR- 20000/-. Through Fistful of Grains project we collected INR- 81,155/- These food grains were distributed among Navjeevan Centre Kalyan, PreranaNaunihal Children's Home, Kharghar, Sisters Adorers, Marol and Manav Jeevan Seva Trust Ghatkopar.

As the COVID-19 crisis continues to loom over us, the underprivileged need support and care. Soroptimist Welfare Association (SIBC) in association with MES's Pillai College of Education

and Research, Chembur organized a 'Donate a Meal Drive' with an aim to provide food to Orphanage and Shelter Homes. The drive raised a total of 1,05,024/-.

#### Placements:

College placement serves as an **outstanding platform for the students** to gain specific skills related to their subject of choice or domain to stay ahead of the competition by providing them adequate job market exposure.

MES's PCER, Chembur in association with Placement Cell organized an Add on Course on the topic 'Being Job Perfect' from January, 2021- February, 2021. Hence PCER organizes various webinar, workshops and expert talks. PCER has owned a YouTube channel as the pandemic situation put restrictions on the physical movements on people. The faculty members were delivering lectures, organized workshops and training programs individually and in collaboration with various university departments, NGOs, Institutions and schools.
