EDITORIAL DESK

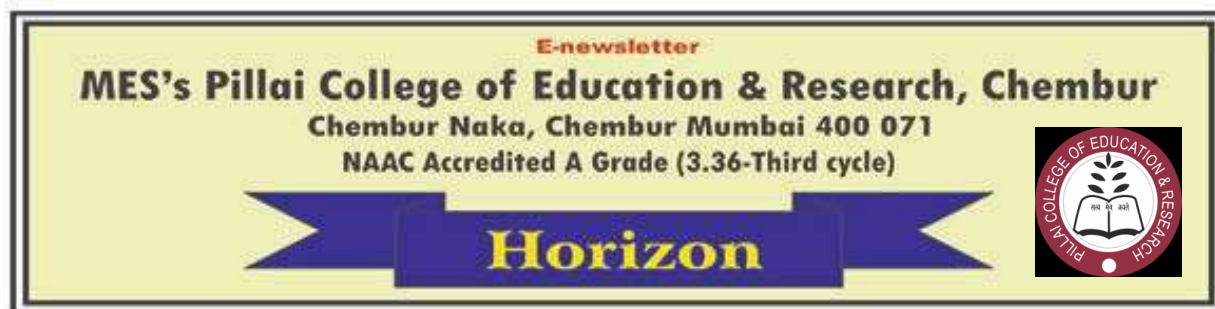

Resource Person: Ms. Jaya Cherian

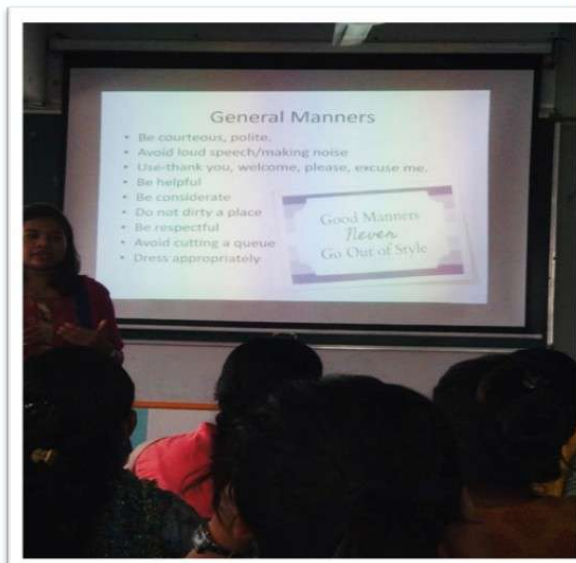

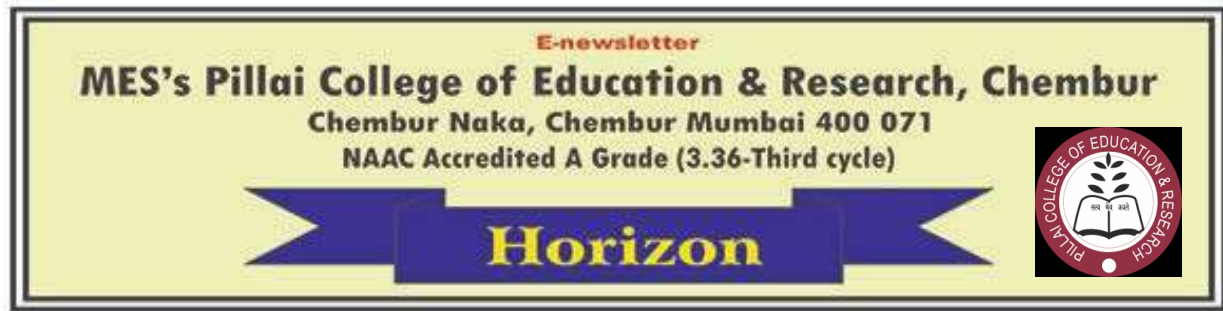
- Correct usage of plurals

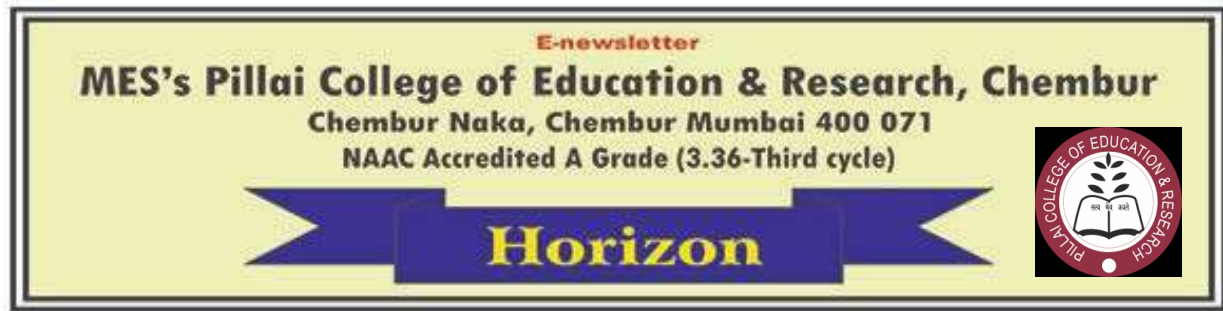

The day following Navratri known as Dussehra is the celebration of triumph of good over evil as it is the day when Lord Ram vanquished Ravana, the king of asuras.

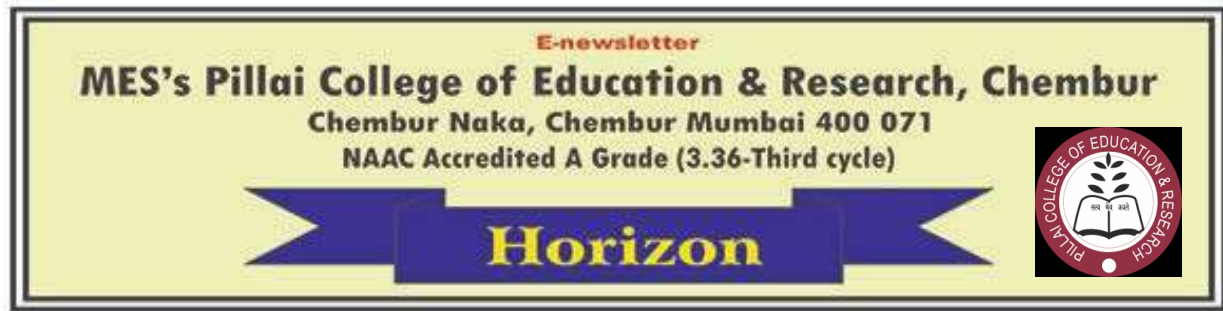
