The activities helped the student teacher to learn planning & organizational skills.

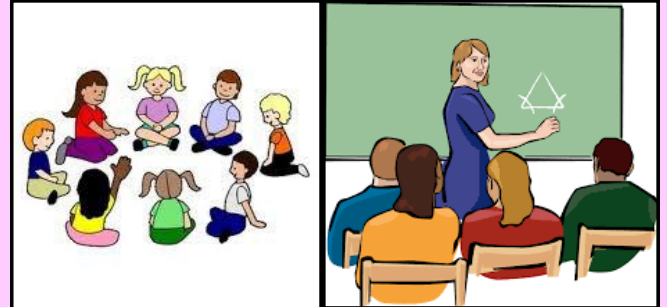

Our Tutorial was incharge of Dessert and we served homemade Payasam and Masala Chas

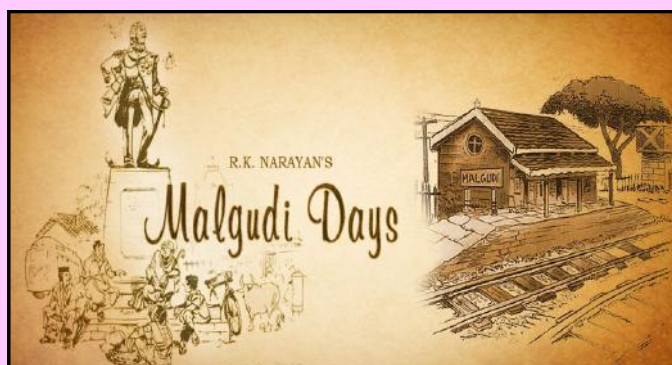


READING AND EXPERIENCING THE TEXT

She explained and demonstrated the procedure of Emboss Painting to the peers.

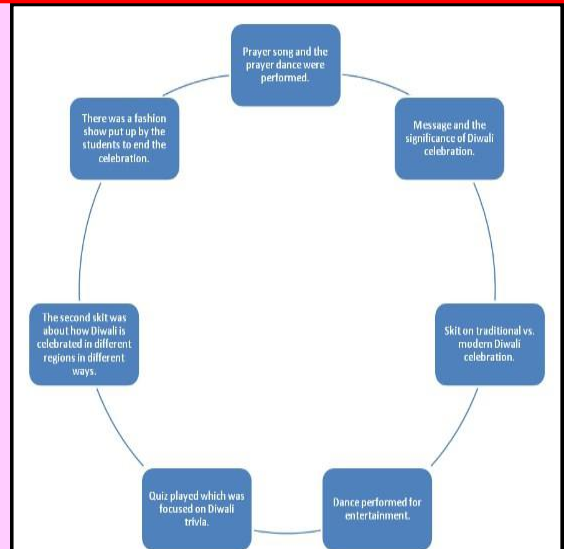
The Tutorial group started with their work on Emboss painting cloth. There was discussion and some suggestion on the colours to be applied.

Certificates were distributed to the Alumni and simultaneously photographs were taken.

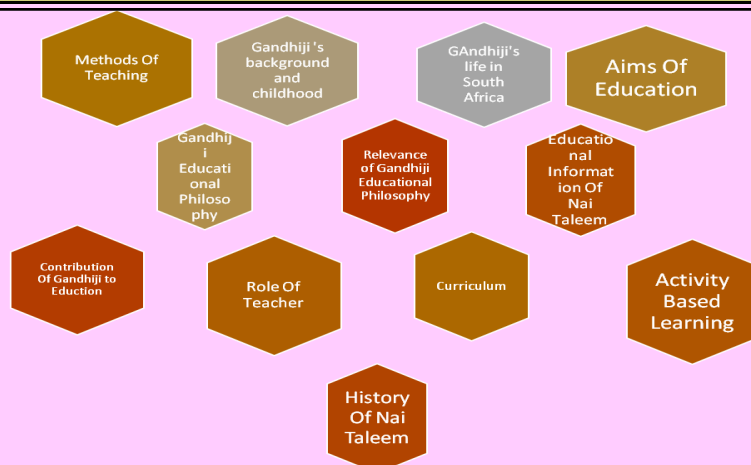
Our Principal ma'am gave a speech on the importance of education to modern society.

To develop an understanding of the various avenues in education made available through Technology.

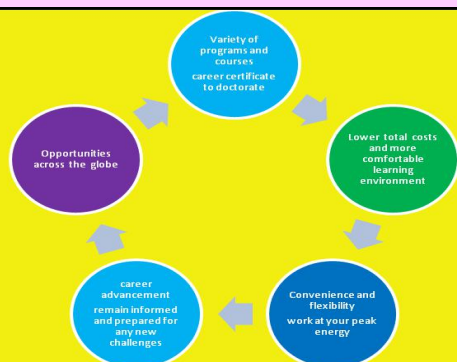
To sensitize & create awareness about various online resources available to enrich learning.

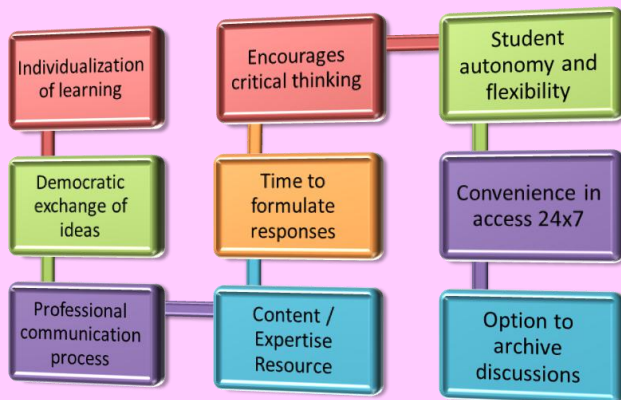
