**Dr. Sunita Jain conducted a Workshop on “Core Elements and Values” on 24th June, 2017.**

One of the recommendations by NPE 1986 was based on a national curricular framework which contains a common core along with other components that are flexible. The common core included the history of India's freedom movement, the constitutional obligations and other content essential to nurture national identity. These elements cut across subject areas and are designed to promote values such as India's common cultural heritage, egalitarianism, democracy and secularism, equality of the sexes, protection of the environment, removal of social barriers, observance of the small family norm and inculcation of the scientific temper. Student teachers were trained using think-pair-share cooperative methodology to have a practical knowledge of how to incorporate core element and values in teaching learning process.

**Dr. Sneha Raikar conducted a Workshop for student teachers on “Emotional Intelligence: Role of a Teacher”.** The workshop helped student teachers to gain valuable emotional insights and awareness to inspire and maintain productive relationships, to identify the impact their emotional intelligence has on connecting with others and to practice listening skills that build and maintain empathy.

**Objectives of the workshop were**

- To find out the level of Emotional Intelligence among the students.
- To improve team effectiveness by raising awareness and managing team emotions.

**Ms. Vinita Desai conducted a Workshop for student teachers on “Effective Classroom Management”.** Students were made to narrate their experiences during 4 weeks internship programme in schools.

Objectives of the workshop were to enable students to develop strategies for Effective Classroom Management.

The workshop focussed teacher as a role model and the qualities that every teacher should foster to be effective in the profession. It showed the transitional role of a classroom from being highly connected to highly disconnected with the passage of time. It highlighted the few errors done by teachers in the classroom; this was given by videos and images. The common errors were categorised as – Errors in Communication, Errors in Classroom management and discipline, Professionalism, curriculum transaction, general errors. The workshop highlighted the various issues we face in our classroom and how the teacher could take decision in such cases. It was through movie clippings, self-explanatory pictures, case studies, brainstorming, understanding of Core and Professional competency in detail. The workshop also highlighted various aspects that every student should remember in their classroom practices.

PCER in alignment with its vision and mission of creating humane and self-reliant teachers provides various opportunities to student teachers to develop and enhance their skills and talents and thus make them ready for the professional field. With this objective through the Life/Effect course students are provided with the requisite awareness and skills. The activities that were conducted during November by the Placement Cell include the following:



**Common Errors in Communication:** The session focused on the importance of communicating correctly and conveying one's thoughts and ideas in a clear and concise manner. The session highlighted the common errors committed during communication in English language such as usage of wrong plurals, the importance of adding the modal after a 'Wh' word, use of *can't* vs *could*. The session also highlighted the importance of correct pronunciations, introducing oneself correctly and the right use of prepositions and articles for grammatically correct sentences. Students were also advised to refer to dictionaries and conduct spell check to avoid spelling errors. The session concluded with a general discussion on the students' queries regarding correct English language usage.

**SWOC Analysis:** Self-awareness is crucial as a well-adjusted adult. Teachers need to be aware of their strengths and weaknesses and the sessions gave them the opportunity to self-reflect and explore these for themselves. Student teachers on the brink of exploring the world of work need to be well equipped not only with their knowledge and skills related to teaching, but also their knowledge about themselves, awareness of the levels of their skills and developing the right attitudes towards their students.
