

March also marks the beginning of spring, a time of renewal and growth. It is a time to embrace change and look forward to the opportunities that lie ahead.



ICON OF INDIA presented the award for Best Principal to Dr. Reni Francis on the Occasion of International Women's Day - 2023.









The special assembly concluded with the chief guest's








Research Methodology Course 13 March - 24 March








Expert Talk on International Pi Day by Mr. Gyanendra Pratap Singh

Mahatma Education Society's Pillai College of Education and Research, Chembur celebrated 'The International Pi Day ' on 14th March 2023 on this year's theme 'Mathematics is everywhere' by organizing an expert talk by Mr. Gyanendra Pratap Singh, HOD of the Department of Mathematics of Dr. Pillai Global Academy, New Panvel.

Mr. Gyanendra Pratap Singh described the history and origin of the p (Pi). He explained about the concepts related to pi like the irrational and infinite numbers. He also discussed the contribution of various scientists like Archimedes, Aryabhatta, Sir Isaac Newton and discussed their research work. He also highlighted uses of pi in the real world, including its use in engineering, physics, and astronomy. The session was very interactive and encouraged student teachers to learn about mathematics and promote math education.





Free oral Cancer Screening And Dental Check up Camp, 21st March

Free oral cancer screening and dental checkup camp were organized by PCER, Chembur. collaboration with MGM hospitals, Kalamboli, dated 21st March, 2023. The main aim is to raise awareness about oral cancer and promote oral health. These camps typically provide free oral cancer screening, dental checkup etc. During these camps, trained healthcare professionals perform a visual and physical examination of the oral cavity to look for signs of cancer. They referred for further treatment or follow-up care if necessary. They may also provide education and street play on oral health and cancer prevention.

Overall, this camp was a valuable resource for individuals who may not have regular access to oral health care or who may be at risk for oral cancer. These camps help to identify dental issues early on, which can lead to better outcome and lower costs in the long term.

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

Workshop for science and non-science Teachers using Low-Cost Teaching Aids -Training The Teachers

Mahatma Education Society's Pillai College of Education and Research Chembur organized an insightful workshop for student teachers in collaboration with the Vigyan Setu Foundation on 24th March and 1st April, 2023. The workshop focused on educating budding teachers on how to use lowcost teaching aids to teach science concepts effectively and making science education more engaging.

Dr. Meena Sharma, retired head of the Physics department from K. J. Somaiya College of Science and Commerce, Vidya Vihar, and Dr. Lalit Sharma, managing trustee of Vigyan Setu Foundation, conducted the workshop. The resource persons demonstrated to the participants how low-cost teaching aids can be used to teach physics concepts related to mechanics, optics, and sound. The participants were introduced to various concepts such as Newton's laws of motion, atmospheric pressure, surface tension, center of gravity, Bernoulli's effect, and many more, using simple and costeffective means.

The participants were encouraged to create the teaching aids themselves using the materials provided by the Vigyan Setu Foundation. Through hands-on activities, the teachers learned how to create simple and effective teaching aids that could be used in their classrooms to teach science concepts. The session was filled with fun activities such as making a self-made helicopter with just paper and scissors and flying it, understanding concepts using cups, balloons, matchbox, and coins.

The student teachers' enthusiasm and active participation were laudable. They appreciated the efforts and left the workshop with newfound knowledge and inspiration to make science education more enjoyable for their students.



WOMEN


Everybody laughs.
