

Dr Sharda stated that the curriculum is more rigorous than the Indian Certificate of Secondary Education (ICSE) curriculum. Students who study IGCSE are well-prepared for further study at university or college.

The IGCSE curriculum offers a wider range of subjects: 70 subjects, and 30 languages. Through the session the student teachers were able to gain an understanding of the different school boards and the learning experiences provided to the learners.






Debate -National Energy Conservation Day

The foggy and gloomy clouds were crying out for aid.


Trailing around the destituent air, I finally woke up from the nightmare.
