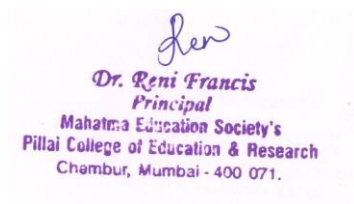
Agenda VI: Best Practices for the academic year 2024-25

Agenda V: Discussion on Institutional distinctiveness


