- The paper has to be typed in Times New Roman, font size 12, and 1.5 line spacing.
- The paper should be a word file with 1½ inch margin on the left and 1 inch margin on the right.
- The paper should not exceed 2500 words. The manuscript should not exceed 6 pages including graphs, tables, and appendices.
- The first page of the manuscript must contain the title of the paper, author's name, mailing address, e-mail address, and acknowledgments, if any.
- References should be given at the end of the paper and should be as per the APA style. All notes must be serially numbered and given at the bottom of the page as footnotes. In the case of website references, the authors should provide the entire URL.
- Authors must run a plagiarism check on their paper and attach the plagiarism report along with their submission email.
- Selected papers will be published in peer-reviewed e-journal.

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
